

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q:"How do we handle the final arrangements of our party?"**

We look forward to speaking with you a month prior to your event. Our team coordinators will review all the specific details of your party insuring the proper casting & production of your event. We will answer all your questions, make suggestions & tie up any loose ends. Our team coordinators are always available to help you.

**Q:"Do we need to meet with the MC or DJ before our party?"**

Usually it is not necessary. Upon speaking with our final coordinator, you will know that your party is in great hands! Our Coordinators will direct all the intimate details to your crew members. If you still desire, we can have your MC or DJ call you after we have gone over all your final arrangements. At that time, you may determine whether you need to meet before your party.

**Q:"How many candles are there for the candle lighting ceremony?"**

Generally there are 13 candles, with one extra for good luck. It is ok to have more, but we suggest that you do not exceed 18 candles. Your candle lighting should not last more than 20 minutes so please keep the poems short. Please take the time to print clearly when completing all forms.

**Q:"What is the proper arrangement of candles?"**

The customary order is as follows: Memorial candle(if any) followed by grandparents, uncles, aunts, cousins, family friends, honoree's friends, siblings, parents and finishing with a good luck candle for our guest of honor.

**Q:"What songs should I select for those distinguished guests lighting candles?"**

Please refer to the suggested song list provided in this package.

**Q:"Can we request a song that is not on your list?"**

Yes, simply indicate the title & artist of the song & we will do our best to satisfy your request. Sometimes, our clients supply us with copies of additional music selections.

**Q:"When are the blessings & toasts performed?"**

The blessing over the bread is performed after the grand entrance, preceded by the candle lighting ceremony. The toast is typically done after the 1st course, following a traditional honor dance. (This may vary depending on your caterer & venue)

**Q:"What is the grand entrance?"**

The grand entrance, a customary part of your festivities, is made by the entire family. The guest of honor will enter last, accompanied by dancers. (Different variations can be discussed when we finalize your party.)

**Q:"Can we request a particular dancer for our party?"**

Our dance coordinator will do their best to honor all requests prior to casting. Please keep in mind however, that our performers are scheduled based on availability. Customarily, we select the dancers that we feel will best compliment your event.

**Q:"How will the dancers be dressed for my party?"**

The dancers are dressed in black formal club wear. Most of our clients prefer that we blend in among their guests. The dancers' talent will allow them to shine. However, upon your request, thematic costuming can be provided.

**Q:"What role do the dancers play in the cocktail hour?"**

Your dancers enter into your cocktail hour with contagious excitement. They will interact & mingle with all the children. This gives them the opportunity to get the kids hyped up to party for the rest of the event.

**Q:"Can you provide a pianist for the cocktail hour?"**

Yes, the embellishments of our live musicians will give your party an elegant flare. Very often when the adults & children are in separate rooms during the cocktail hour, our clients request either a pianist or a trio for the adults & DJ music for the children. It is also very entertaining to have the musicians accompany the DJ during the reception.

**Q:"Can you suggest any other entertainment for our event?"**

We offer over 125 novelty concepts, ranging from Poster Mania, Celebrity Rock Videos, Digital Photo Booths, Multitalents, Sign Shop, Karaoke and many more. These services can be added to your event by asking our team coordinator.

**Q:"Do you offer customized CD'S?"**

Yes, this is very popular. Your child can choose his/her songs & we can produce all the graphics to design a CD cover that carries the theme of your event.

**Q:"Do you offer private dance lessons?"**

Absolutely! Our dancers & choreographers can travel to your home & teach your child & family the latest dance steps. You can call us & speak with the dance coordinator at least a month prior to your event. We offer all varieties of dance techniques from "Break Dancing" to "Broadway". Any custom dance routine needs at least 3 lessons. Please call our team coordinator for pricing.

**Q:"Do you offer prizes other than Party Favors?"**

We have the hottest artist's CD singles & posters, black-light items, inflatable sofa chairs, flashlight sunglasses & much, much, more. This Prize Pack can be added to your event. Ask about our "UP CLOSE & PERSONAL" trivia game.

**Q:"Can you make us a Picture Montage & provide a Video Projection Screen?"**

We will create a Picture Video Montage for all your family & friends to enjoy. We also offer Video Projection Screens as well as 40-inch TV monitors which can incorporate your montage on screen with Live Simulcasting, Digital Pictures, Music Videos & thematic movie scenes to complete the theme of your event.

**Q:"How do I pay my balance?"**

Your balance is due 10 days prior to your event. Any last minute add-ons must be paid in cash or money order before the start of your party.

**Q:"When do my montage pictures need to be sent in?"**

Pictures must be received no later than 4 weeks prior to your event to complete montage.

**Q:"Are gratuities expected and/or appropriate?"**

**Gratuities are accepted and greatly appreciated by our entertainers. Gratuities are generally 5-10% of your entertainment package.**
